IAN GOLDIN

Director James Martin 21st Century School, Oxford University

Ian Goldin was Vice President of the World Bank (2003 – 2006) and prior to that the Bank's Director of Development Policy (2001 – 2003). He served on the Bank's senior management team, and was directly responsible for its relationship with the UK and all other European, North America and developed countries.

From 1996 – 2001 Ian Goldin was Principal Economist at the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) in London, and Program Director at the OECD Development Centre in Paris.

Born in South Africa, Ian Goldin studied at the University of Cape Town and the London School of Economics, before taking a doctorate at Oxford University.

Ian Goldin has received wide recognition for his contributions to development and research, including being nominated Chevalier by the French Government and Global Leader of Tomorrow by the World Economic Forum.

He had published over 50 articles and 12 books. In addition to being Director of the School, Goldin holds a Professorial Fellowship at Balliol College, Oxford.
