CALL FOR TRACKS

We invite you to jointly explore the role of entrepreneurship and innovation in preparing students for a fast-changing, challenging world that requires innovative and creative thinking and brave and responsible leadership.

To this end, we kindly invite fellow researchers (PRME community and beyond) to share their valued expertise and submit a **track proposal** on their particular fields of interest. We welcome both, established and emerging topics that draw significant attention within "Societal Impact through Entrepreneurship & Innovation: Responsible Leadership Education for the Changemakers of tomorrow".

Track chair responsibilities

We are looking for track chairs with a sufficient level of seniority with regards to research experience, recognition in the field (of the track proposed), e.g. through publications, editorial experience and other academic impact. The responsibilities of the track chairs include:

- Physical Attendance at the RMER Conference in Innsbruck
- Liaising with the Conference Program Committee on all matters that concern the RMER Conference
- Promoting the track and take sufficient measures to ensure an adequate number of submissions
- Acting as reviewer of the papers submitted to the track and/or recruiting suitable peers to review the submissions
- Chairing their tracks during the conference

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Review process

Each proposal will be evaluated and reviewed by the Conference Program Committee. Acceptance decisions will be based on

- conference theme fit
- overall quality of proposal and significance of topic
- relevance for intended target audience

Based on this, the Conference Program Committee can accept track proposals as submitted, provide suggestions for modification or improvement or reject proposals, which do not meet the criteria listed above. The Program Committee may also give constructive feedback for modifying a proposal and may suggest the integration of different proposals in situations of theme overlaps and an insufficient number of paper submissions.

Track submission guidelines and form

To submit a track proposal please, follow the link below and complete the form, entering a track title and a short track description (min of 500 words and max. 750). The track description should include relevant literature and keywords (max. 5), explaining how the track illustrates, expands, or innovates on the conference theme, drawing out the target groups that are interested in the subject and will be invited to contribute. Please, also, share information regarding your person (name, affiliation, email address) and a short biography including publications (PDF format required). Please note that individuals can propose a maximum of two tracks.
