Whilst developing their language skills and expanding their international network even further, this program offers students the opportunity to specialise in one of two majors, either Financial Management or Human Resource Management. Furthermore, students have the unique possibility to organise their internship in Finland and thereby gain valuable work experience. Upon successful completion of the Double Degree Bachelor program, students will be awarded a Bachelor of Business Administration from HAAGA-HELIA University of Applied Sciences in addition to their Bachelor of Arts in Business from MCI | The Entrepreneurial School®.
