Statute | Status 1 June 2019

- The MCI Advisory Board advises and supports the Entrepreneurial School® in its strategic orientation and further development as well as in achieving its goals.
- 2. The members of the Advisory Board are respected figures from business, science and society who support the Rector and the Entrepreneurial School® with their experience, competence, commitment and contacts, in achieving these goals.
- 3. The MCI Advisory Board provides the rector of the Entrepreneurial School® the opportunity to discuss and reflect on the strategic considerations of the school within a circle of proven experts.
- 4. The MCI Advisory Board offers its members the opportunity to network with the academic world, gain insight into its topics, activities and developments, contribute expertise and initiate new approaches.
- 5. The MCI Advisory Board meets once a year in Innsbruck, where feasible. In individual cases, Advisory Board meetings may also be arranged at other locations. Independently, there is the possibility of individual exchanges during the year.
- 6. The MCI Advisory Board is not a corporate or higher education body (e.g. supervisory board, shareholders' meeting, university collegium), and members are not burdened by such related tasks, competencies and responsibilities.
- 7. The Rector shall appoint the members of the Advisory Board. The term of office is 5 years, beginning at the time of commitment and ending automatically at the end of that period. A reappointment is permissible. The work is undertaken on a voluntary basis and is therefore not remunerated.
