Frank Sieren studied Political Science with a focus on Economics at Trier University and subsequently at the Otto Suhr Institute of the Free University of Berlin. He is one of Germany's leading experts on China.

A journalist, bestselling author and documentary filmmaker, Frank Sieren has been living in Beijing since 1994 - longer than any other Western business journalist. From this unique vantage point, he has been witnessing China's remarkable rise firsthand and has earned an outstanding reputation through his high-quality reports and analyses of China's political and economic development.

Throughout his journalistic career, he has reported from China for leading German publications including *Süddeutsche Zeitung*, *WirtschaftsWoche*, *Die Zeit* and *Handelsblatt*. He is also a distinguished columnist for Gabor Steingart's *The Pioneer*.

His numerous bestselling books, including *Future? China!*, *Shenzhen and China to Go*, as well as his latest book, *Der Auto-Schock*, explore China's transformation and its emergence as a global superpower. Frank Sieren has authored more books on China than any other German journalist and has also produced highly acclaimed television documentaries for ARD and ZDF.

Frank Sieren is co-founder and moderator of the Media Forum China of the Bosch Stiftung, a high-level annual gathering of German and Chinese journalists established in 2010. Since 2017, the forum has brought together journalists and policy makers from Germany, China and the United States in a trilateral format. Anyone seeking to understand China and its role in today's world will find few voices with the depth of experience and insight of Frank Sieren.
