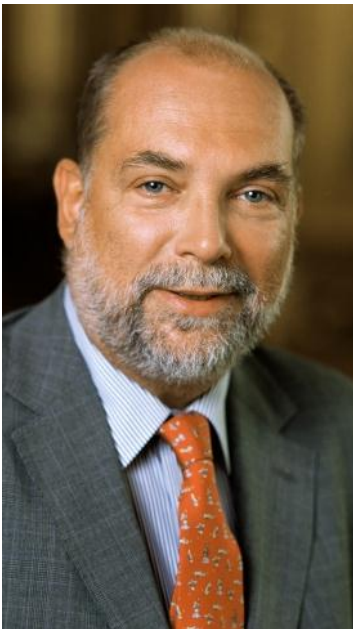

was there a euro crisis - or is there a globalisation crisis?

Thomas Wieser, an Austrian national, was born in the US in 1954. He has been appointed as President of the Euro Working Group, which following a decision by Heads of State or Government in October 2011 was made a full-time and Brussels based job.

Prior to his present appointment, he was Director General for Economic Policy and Financial Markets in the Ministry of Finance, Vienna, in charge of macro-economic policy, international and EU affairs, financial market legislation, and export credits and guarantees.

After a degree in Economics (University of Innsbruck), he pursued post-graduate studies in theoretical and mathematical economics, and taught, at the University of Colorado, Boulder (Fulbright scholarship) and the Institute of Advanced Studies, Vienna.

Prior to his appointment in the Ministry of Finance he spent 4 years as an economist in EFTA in Geneva, where he also was in charge of negotiations with the EU on state aid affairs. Prior to that, he worked in banking in Vienna, and as a research economist. Mr. Wieser has published articles in journals and periodicals on national and international economic policy issues.
