Former President of the Czech Republic

1941	Born in Prague
1963	Graduation in International economic relations and international trade, Prague School of Economics
1963–1970	Researcher, Institute of Economics of the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences
1971–1986	Various positions in the Czechoslovak State Bank
1989	Co-Founder of the Czechoslovak Civic Forum Movement (OF)
1990	Chairman of the Czechoslovak Civic Forum Movement
up from 1991	Co-Founder and Chairman of the Civic Democratic Party/ODS
1989-1992	First non-communist finance minister after more than forty years of communist rule
1992-1997	Prime Minister of the Czech Republic
1998	President of the Chamber of Deputies of the Czech Parliament
2003–2013	President of the Czech Republic

Václav Klaus has received multiple honorary doctorate degrees – also from the University of Innsbruck – and international awards in various countries.
